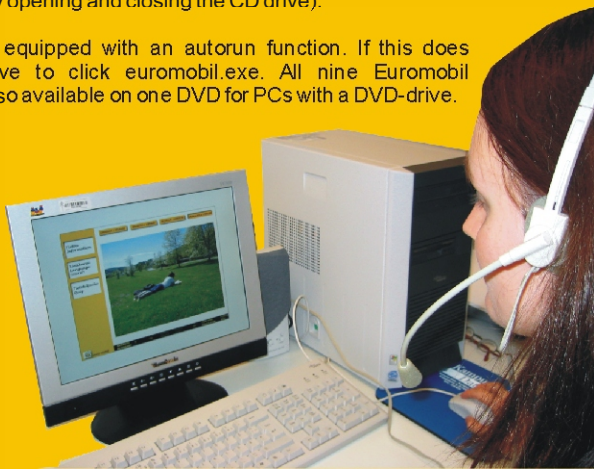


System requirements

PC minimum Pentium III (900 Mhz) or higher, 512 MB RAM, Windows 98/NT 4.0/2000/XP/Me/Vista, minimum screen setting 800x600 pixels, recommended 1024x768 pixels, CD drive, sound card, headphones or loudspeakers.

For the German, English and Finnish programmes, you will also need a microphone and a Quicktime player (in order to be able to view the video sequences). When the CD is first started, it automatically checks whether Quicktime 3.0 or higher is already installed. If the Quicktime player is detected, the Euromobil programme will start automatically. If not, the installation of Quicktime will start automatically. After this, the Euromobil programme will have to be restarted (by clicking euromobil.exe or by opening and closing the CD drive).

All CD-ROMs are equipped with an autorun function. If this does not work you have to click euromobil.exe. All nine Euromobil programmes are also available on one DVD for PCs with a DVD-drive.


